Thank you for your trust, and we wish you lots of fun in the Ardennes! In this note, we would like to share some practical information.

- **Address of the holiday home:** Aisne 7, 6941 Heyd, Belgium.
Take exit 48 bis on the E25 and then take the 3rd road on the right towards the village of Harre (Rue du Châtaignier). This road leads you through the centre of Harre via a number of road narrows. Continue downhill through the woods until you reach 'Moulin de Harre'. At this T-junction, turn left towards Deux-Rys. Continue along the road until you reach the junction with Hotel Au-Romain (N806). Here, turn right towards Bomal. After a few kilometres, you will pass through the village of Aisne. Continue along the road and turn right at the next junction towards Villers Sainte Gertrude. 'La maison en pierre bleue' is the first house you come across on the left. There is parking space for about 5 cars. Please do not park on the public road.
- We have provided a key safe at the window of the technical room, recognizable by the two black tubes that stick out, to facilitate checking in and out. The large key can be used for all the outside doors of the main building. The small key can be used to lock windows if there are small children, for example. The annex is used for storing (garden) tools and is not accessible. When checking out, please close all windows and doors and hang the keys back in the safe.
- The heating works with a central thermostat in the dining room (behind the door). First set the thermostat to the desired temperature and then open the radiators where necessary. Please set the thermostat to 15 degrees when checking out.
- Both in the kitchen and in the dining room you will find a fridge and freezer combination. You can switch these on and off with the rotary knob in the fridge. Please switch off the appliances and leave the doors slightly open when checking out. An extra fridge can be found in the bar.
- In the dining room there is a Nespresso coffee cup machine and a regular coffee maker available.
- Don't forget to bring dishcloths, kitchen towels, toilet paper, washing-up liquid, dishwasher tablets and possibly tablecloths.
- On level 2 you will find a large bathroom and three bedrooms with single beds (90 cm x 200 cm). On level 3 you will find a small bathroom and four bedrooms with double beds (160 cm x 200 cm). Pillows and duvets are provided in each room. You must bring your own fitted sheets, duvet covers and pillowcases. There are two travel cots and two cots available.



- There is a BBQ on the terrace. Remember to provide charcoal and kindling and clean the grill(s) after use.
- Please respect the tranquility of the area and avoid noise pollution (mandatory between 10pm and 6am).
- Please separate waste into (a) paper and cardboard, (b) PMD, (c) glass and (d) other. At the end of your stay, please collect the waste from all bins. Paper and cardboard can be left in the grey bins in the garage (level 0). PMD can be placed in the black container opposite the key safe and other items in the large compartment of the grey duo bin. Garbage bags are available onsite. A glass container can be found on Rue Gilles Bouvet - 6941 Durbuy (Villers Ste Gertrude), opposite house number 22.
- The garage door controls are located next to the light switch. By pressing the top black button you can open and close it.
- In Aisne there is a bakery (Aisne 39 - Heyd) and in Bormal you will find a supermarket (Spar) and a butcher (Keirse).
- There are some cabinets with a lock. Behind these are our personal belongings.
